In an interconnected world with linked economies, international collaboration is critical for addressing global challenges and fostering sustainable economic growth. The Group of Twenty, or G20, has evolved as a critical platform for promoting conversation and collaboration among the world's largest countries. The G20, founded in 1999 in response to the late-90s financial crises, has evolved to play a crucial role in establishing global economic policy. Later on, during the 2008 financial crisis, the G20 gained prominence. Recognizing the necessity for a concerted response to avert a global economic disaster, G20 leaders began convening at the summit level. This watershed moment cemented the G20's position as the leading forum for worldwide economic cooperation.





The G20 is made up of 19 individual countries and the European Union, representing a varied variety of economies ranging from major powerhouses such as the United States, China, and Germany to rising economies such as Brazil, India, and South Africa. It is a group of countries which holds 60% of the population of world, contributes 75% of world's trade and accounts for 85% of GDP of the world.

The G20 has two tracks namely 1) Financial Track and 2) Sherpa Track. In Financial track finance ministers and Central banks discuss policies like Global Economic growth, Tax Information Exchange, Financial Regulatory Inclusion, Financial remittances Reforms, across the world, Fossil fuel Subsidies, Green finance and Anti Terrorism financing. Whereas, in Sherpa track Diplomats discuss policies such as Employment, Climate Change, Agriculture and food security, Anti corruption measures, UN sustainable development Goals, and Improvement of Healthcare.

To perform for the agenda of G20, the responsibility lies on the shoulders of three parties firstly, the past president which was Indonesia, the present president which is India, and the future president which will be Brazil.

# INTERVIEW WITH Dr. ASHVINI VORA

# Q. Can u please provide some information on your academic journey and your Professional Career?

So I started in 1980 & throughout my life, I remain as a vising faculty only. I never opt for a full-time faculty. I have specialization in marketing and HR. By graduation, I'm a doctor. Then I did my MBA. Further did my Ph.D. in HealthCare Management at the age of 60. I was probably 1st in Gujarat, to do a Ph.D. in the hospital sector & pioneer to start a healthcare program in Gujarat. Started from B.K. and joined as a consultant with the Indian Institute of Public and worked for 5 years. The whole program for MBA in hospital management is designed by me. Then I worked as a consultant with Ahmedabad Institute of Medical Sciences. For 14 years, I have been taking an evening program at B.K. School of Professional and management studies. At present, I am the program director at Indrashil University and Cadila Life Sciences. I am running online programs in Doctoral education, BYJU's twice a week. In B.K., I have taken a variety of subjects like Organizational Behaviour, Services marketing, Executive program and data, principles of management, Ethical Governance, Sales & Distribution Management, Logistics and retailing Management at Som-Lalit Institute also Pharmaceutical management at L.M. Pharma.



# Q. I have also heard that you are a kind of fitness freak.

Yes, Exactly. I educate many times to my students regarding this. In my last lecture only I tought them "Obesity is the economic problem of the country". I keep myself fit with yoga. In this way, you will physically and mentally feel fit.

# Q. What role did you exactly play in HealthWeg?

One of my students wanted to initiate a startup and she said ma'am please be with me otherwise it is not possible. Therefore, we launched this startup as HealthWeg, in that we are more focused on diabetes, obesity & PCO. At present, we are giving online consultancy and later on, we add yoga also which will help them to connect with doctors as well. Everything is done through software; hence we only have to monitor, and develop contacts and networks. We opened offices in Delhi and Bangalore recently.

# Q. So, coming from a generation, we easily get demotivated, even by a little inconvenience we face, so what is your approach towards the challenges of failures in life and what suggestion would you like to give to us?

I always take challenges as a positive factor that you don't have to disheartened when you face a challenge, you have to accept and try to find out solution with patience and stability. So, I think patience in this generation is very low. You should develop yourself in the full package as a management student because internal growth is also required as much as external growth. Today, we discussed about the movie "12th fail". I was telling them, it is not necessary to wear tie, blazer, etc. during my any presentation or interview because they start to feel uncomfortable and your raises our expectations interviewer's expectation due to which we pressure on students our expectation are raised through package.

# Q. Ma'am any specific hobby or interests you have?

I manage home very well. I learnt music for becoming a good and effective faculty. Still I am continuing to learn about vocals and play Tabla and keyboard also. I don't like to go for kitty parties. I like reading too much and for that we have a very huge library at home. Mostly read spiritual, philosophical and self-development books.

Q. Ma'am can you recall a specific project or campaign that stands out as a highlight in your long and successful career like any at the times of your PH.D.?

After Ph.D, I gave consultancy to so many hospitals and I have done international projects also in hospital, infrastructure providing all the necessary information. I have worked on Tanzaniyam project to develop the primary health centers in the wildlife centuries. Even in AdisaBaba Ethopia, I have raised one multispecialty hospital there and given consultancy. Currently, I am working in Sikkim for only consultancy in hospitals. I took students with me, so that they start earning and learning that consultancy can be done. I want my students to open-up with me and don't be afraid of me. Because I don't want my students to be humiliated in corporates. To maintain discipline in classroom, as I believe it is the temple of Goddess Sraswati. But outside of that 4 wall of classroom, I am very friendly and help getting students in many placements.

Q. After listening to you, you don't come from a generation which is very cool. At that time women has to face a lot, so how did you manage the demanding career and those relations because as you said that your father was from background so he must have been strict with the principles and disciplines. So how did you Manage all these things? It was very difficult but once I decide then I will do. I kept my area or choices separate from my husband's choices. I never joined our businesses because we both were intelligent as he handled the factory and I remained on the academics side. So there were no discussion or anything that we can compete with eachother. Because for me his area was different from mine. All the universities have supported particularly B.K. I have always helped other faculties and never expected anything in return.

Q. Ma'am you have earned professional achievements. Can you share a principles that has guided you in your personal growth?

Bhagavad Gita has tremendous effect on me. I follow the principles of Shri Krishna. I have even written a book named "Krishna as a strategic Leader". It is bilingual because in Gujarat most of families belong to middle-class. I have also written books on hospital management which is internationally used as it is published by JP Publication, 2nd largest book publisher. At present, I am writing book of Human Resource. Whenever I get time, I used to write down the notes from whatever I read. I bring those notes in the classroom for students, read those and point out that this is how the things must be analized, discussed on political events in Ram-Janma Bhumi. It helps students in how to open-out in public.

- Q. Concluding it, I would like to just ask one question which is very much important for our generation, it's been a while you are teaching this generation what are the skills we have to inculcate in order to become a good human in life?
- First of all, honesty and integrity. You should develop a strong value system and need to follow that system in whatever work you do. So, that you don't repent in future that what I did and why I did.
- You must be transparent within yourself in this way no question arises in mind regarding your personality. I request all the students of this generation that have patience, think before you do anything, have tolerance and perseverance.
   Nothing can be gained overnight, you have to shake the perspiration and then you will get it.
- It is a long journey, many-a-times people ask faculties that why all students are respecting and touching her (Ashwini ma'am) feet. But to reach up to that level, we have to work very hard and win your hearts.
- I always say that when you see in the mirror you should first love yourself. You should be very enthusiastic regarding your dressing and everything. Go on developing and upgrading your knowledge, confidence, inner strength and willpower continuously.
- When you avoid eye-contacts, it is your non-verbal communications and they speaks a lot about your personality.
   Personality is not what you wear. What is Charishma? "Charishma" is not the beauty, but the impact you put on.



first impression, illustrating this point with stories of interviewees who stood out for all the right reasons.





Output: The model generates a more engaging and imaginative story that delves into the unique elements of the upside-down world and creates an exciting narrative.





#### A Tough Choice: Ethical Dilemma at Apex Pharma
